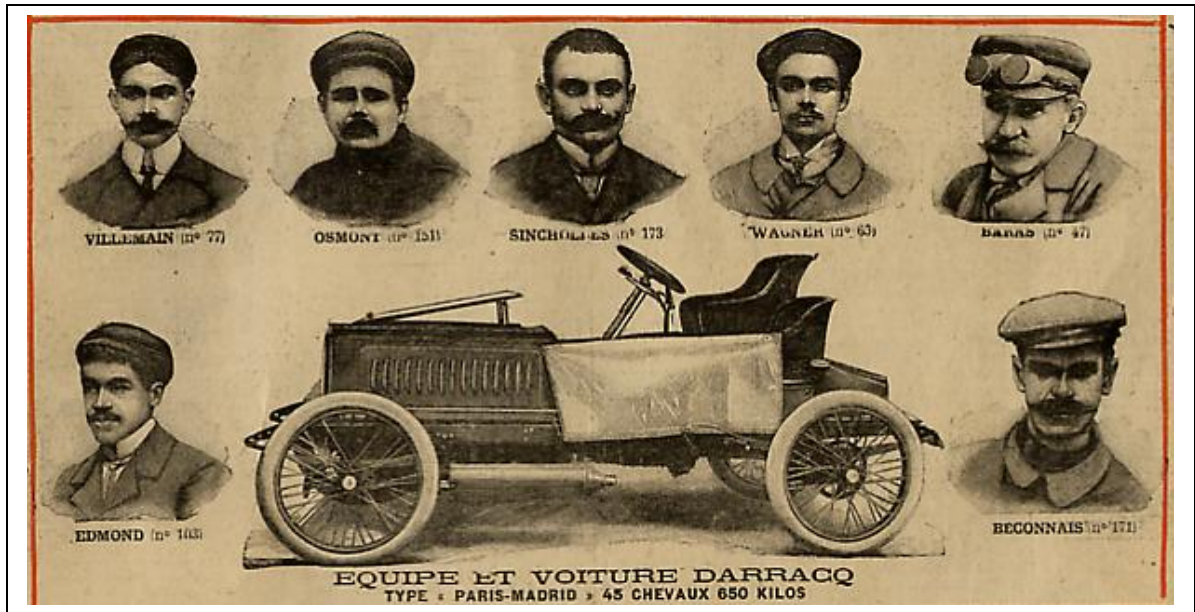
The following comes from a supplement with *Le Petit Parisien* published before the race.
